



**PROCEDURE TO GET THE VEHICLE FITTED WITH WHEEL
ATTACHMENT ENDORSED IN RTO**

1. The modified two-wheeler must be owned by the physically challenged person who is going to use it.
2. Such a person must obtain a medical fitness certificate from the competent medical authority (Civil Surgeon from that area). (Refer the sample Medical Fitness Certificate from ‘Downloads’ section).
3. The vehicle, before the fitment of the retrofit wheel attachment kit, must have temporary registration. (Note that the road tax is exempted for the physically challenged people).
4. Prior approval of the local RTO must be taken on Form BTI, before the fitment of the retrofit wheel attachment kit. (Refer the Form BTI from ‘Downloads’ section).
5. Once the retrofit wheel attachment kit is fitted to the vehicle, the modified vehicle must be endorsed in the local RTO. Following documents are required for the endorsement -
 - Form BTI (Approved by local RTO)
 - Valid certificate of authorized Test Agency (such as ARAI) issued to retrofit kit manufacturer
 - Trade Certificate issued by local RTO to the retrofit kit manufacturer
 - Form 22 issued by kit manufacturer
 - Kit Manufacturer’s certificate
6. Upon submission of the above mentioned documents, necessary entry in the RC about the alteration will be then made by the concerned registering authority. (Permission of alteration will stand withdrawn once the vehicle is sold to some other party).
7. On obtaining the endorsement of the vehicle, the owner of such a vehicle can apply for a driving license.
